Guardian ad Litem Volunteer Training

Guardians ad Litem are citizens who volunteer to represent children before the court, social service agencies and the community. Volunteers are trained and supervised by program staff, including attorneys. On average, Guardians ad Litem devote approximately 6 hours a month & create relationships that can make a huge impact on children's lives.

To become a Guardian, you must be at least <u>21 years old</u>. A criminal background check will be completed on all applicants and you must complete the <u>30 hour pre-service training program</u> to be certified.

Training is 3 days total.
