surrogates. Educational surrogates act as advocates for a child who requires ESE services. Responsibilities include making informed decisions about the child's educational needs, attending meetings, and monitoring the child's progress.

Successful completion of the training and certification as an educational surrogate will qualify you to provide additional advocacy to children receiving ESE services and who have IEPs at school.
